This is in response to your request of June 20, 2021, which arrived in this office on July 7, 2021, under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552, requesting a copy of de-identified airmen with a 1st, 2nd or 3rd class medical certificate who have reported or documented to have taken any of the SARS-COV-2 genetic vaccines from January 2020 to July 1, 2021.

A search was conducted in the Civil Aerospace Medical Institute. We were not able to locate any information concerning airmen with a 1st, 2nd or 3rd class medical certificate who have reported or documented to have taken any of the SARS-COV-2 genetic vaccines from January 2020 to July 1, 2021.

You may request reconsideration of the determination by writing the Assistant Administrator for Finance and Management (AFN-400), Federal Aviation Administration, 800 Independence Avenue. SW Washington DC, 20591 or through electronic mail at: FOIA-Appeals@faa.gov Your request for reconsideration must be made in writing within 90 days from the date of this letter and must include all information and arguments replied upon. Your letter must state that it is an appeal from the above-described denial of a request made under the FOIA. The envelope containing the appeal should be marked "FOIA Appeal."
